Location A ~ Mount Dora Center for the Arts:

Address | 138 E 5th Ave

Our stroll begins here! Fiber Invitational will be the title of the display. The Fiber Invitational will be a delight for the senses. In this exhibit you will be able to feel the ideas, the experiences and inspirations of the multi media designs. Most of the artists in this exhibit are self taught although several artists are well known in their own right whom have exhibited locally, nationally and internationally. The pieces are diverse ranging from pictorial still life to narrative abstract.

Location B ~ The Donnelly Pavilion Building:
